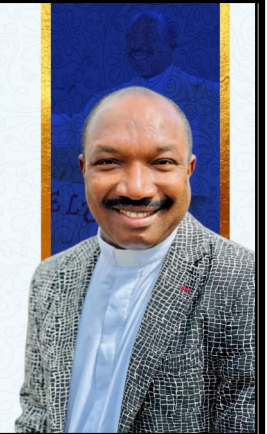

ORDINARY TIME

We have now concluded the Easter season following on from the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. That marked the birth of the church, when the disciples and followers of Jesus were filled with the power of the Holy Spirit.

We now move into the season of Ordinary time, which lasts until the First Sunday of Advent.

Focus

This season is time to focus on growth in faith, hope and love; living out the Good News. It also falls during summer vacation, a good time to take a break from more formal observances.

Mood

This is steady time; time for steadfast, active commitment.

Symbols

Green, growing plants symbolize the season. Vestments and Altar Cloths are changed to green during ordinary time.
