THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS OR THE WAY OF THE CROSS (VIA CRUCIS)

The Stations of the Cross is an ancient religion practice in the Catholic Church that originated in the 12th and 13th centuries among pilgrims in Jerusalem who desires to imitate the footsteps of Jesus on the way to Calvary. It commemorates Jesus's passion and death on the Cross. It provides us an opportunity to reflect on Jesus' death and sacrifice He made for us.

Stations of the Cross is found in all the Catholic Churches, and is particularly prayed on Lenten Fridays but available throughout the year for meditation and reflection on the passion and death of Jesus

The 14th Stations of the Cross was established by a Franciscan monk following biblical account of the passion and death of Jesus Christ. In recent time the 15th Stations which is the way of light (via lucia) was introduced by Pope St John Paul 11 that invites us to meditate on the resurrection of Jesus Christ. The Stations of the Cross is a very important devotion in the Catholic Church that even the Anglican and Lutheran traditions practiced. It is efficacious prayer devotion like the rosary that carries along great miracles to those who practices it. Why not consider joining this devotion faithfully in this Lenten season.
