SYNOD: Following on from our local discernment and feedback to the Church in England and Wales, the Continental phase has now produced a draft “synthesis” for consideration and dialogue by the Church before it is finalised. The final submissions from the continental assemblies will be considered by the assembly of bishops in 2023, with further dialog with local churches before the final assembly in 2024. Please pray for the Synodal process as it continues —the synod prayer is shown below:
