Basic Instruction Before Leaving
Earth (BIBLE)

The word Bible is an English translation of the Latin word "Biblia" and Greek word "Biblios" meaning "The Book". Literally, the word Bible refers to a collection of many books into one book. These books or manuscripts were collected long ago by hagiographers at different periods, among different peoples and in different places, and were edited into one single book call, "The bible" which is considered as the inspired word of God (2 Timothy 3:16-17, 2 Peter 1:19-22, 2 Peter 3;15-16).
