THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

THURSDAY 9TH MAY

The solemnity of the ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ into heaven is a Holyday of Obligation in the Church and it is celebrated like a Sunday. It is traditionally known as "Ascension Thursday" which commemorates the Christian belief of the bodily Ascension of Jesus into Heaven (Acts 1:1-9). This feast is generally observed on a Thursday, the fortieth day after Easter.

As Jesus ascends into heaven, we are reminded of our own ascension at the Parousia, the final coming of Jesus to take us back to his kingdom. Our true destiny is heaven and working for heaven is a fundamental Christian duty.
