PENTECOST NOVENA

The novena in honour of the Holy Ghost is the oldest of all novenas since it was first made at the directions of Our Lord Himself when He sent His Apostles back to Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Ghost on the first Pentecost (Acts 1:12-14). It is still the only novena prescribed by the Church addressed to the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity; it is a powerful plea for the light and strength and love so sorely needed by every Christian. A novena to renew our baptism in the Spirit. Fanning into action our baptismal and confirmation spirit.

Though this novena can be prayed any time of year, it is traditionally prayed from the Friday after Ascension Thursday (when the Ascension is not transferred to the following Sunday) until the Saturday before Pentecost.

Kindly join us at this novena prayers in the church every morning immediately after the rosary. However, you can do your personal Pentecost novena prayers online or with any Pentecost novena book. May the Holy Spirit revive our spirit. Amen.
