WELCOME TO THE SOLEMN CELEBRATION OF THE HOLY WEEK

The Holy Week ushers us in the final journey of the death and resurrection of our Lord's Jesus Christ. The week begins with Palm Sunday that re-enact the triumphant entering of Our Lord Our Jesus Christ to Jerusalem as the universal king who subjected himself to death as a servant king on the cross of Calvary for our salvation.

The week culminates with the Sacred Triduum, the three days of our salvation history, when heavens and earth opened for our liberation by our Lord Jesus Christ. The solemnity begins with the mass of Chrism on Wednesday when the priests renewed their priestly vows of service and oils blessed and consecrated by the bishop for the use of the priests throughout the year. Triduum of Holy Thursday or Maundy Thursday, when the Lord washed the feet of disciples, Good Friday, when he died on the cross and the liturgy of Holy Saturday when he rose from the death as a victor over death.

It is the most important week of our salvation, kindly dedicate your whole being and time to God this week which is often call: The Holy Week, Passion week, Paschal week, Painful week, Authentic week, and the week of Salvation. May he give us the grace to remain faithful. Wishing you all fruitful Holy Week. Amen.
